Terms of Membership

- A 30 day advance written notice is required to cancel/terminate membership.
- My membership payment is for one month in advance.
- A target bank draft or credit/debit card billing date is either the 10th or the 25th day of each month and it does not expire on the renewal date.
- Membership to the YMCA is a privilege, not a right, and the YMCA reserves the right to terminate my membership for behavior that is contrary to the character development traits of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility.
- I am required to bring my membership card and the card for each family member on each visit and present it to the Front Desk for admission.
- The YMCA conducts regular sex offender screenings on all members, participants, and guests. If a sex offender match occurs, the YMCA reserves the right to cancel membership, end program participation, and remove visitation access.
- A photo for my membership is required and at any time a Front Desk representative may ask to renew the photo if it is old or blurry.
- Appropriate dress consistent with a family atmosphere is a MUST! No excessively revealing clothes! Shoes and shirts are required at all times except while in the pool areas (swim trunks and appropriate swim wear is required). I agree to obey all posted rules at the pool.
- I may be asked to provide a copy of my latest tax return as verification for family members in my household.
- **Monthly or annual membership fees will not be refunded due to lack of facility use or any other reason.**
- The maximum number of children allowed in the nursery at one time is 15. The maximum length of stay is 2 hours. I must have a Family/Single Parent Family membership or pay guest fees for my child in order to use the Child Watch services.
- On occasion, video tape or photographs may be taken of me or my family members during program participation and I agree to allow the use of such media materials for the express purpose of YMCA program promotion.
- I acknowledge that I have been informed that the age limit to use the Fitness Center is 13 years old. From the ages of 13-15, the parent must be present in the Fitness Center with the child.
- I will lock my car and valuables in my trunk. If I chose to bring valuables into the facility, I will bring my own lock to lock it up in my perspective locker, or rent a locker from the YMCA. Lockers are available for day use and must be cleaned out at the end of each day if not renting one. If items are left, they will be donated to charity. THE YMCA IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.
- I will use the age appropriate locker rooms. Unisex locker rooms are in the pool hallway and can be used to change children ages 3 months to 5 years. YOU MUST USE AGE APPROPRIATE LOCKERS!
- Use of electronic devices, camera or video recording devices is prohibited in ALL locker rooms and restrooms.
- The joining fee is non-refundable, one-time fee paid when I join. If I voluntarily cancel/terminate my membership and decide to rejoin over 6 months after leaving, I will be required to repay the join fee.
- I am able to place my membership on hold for up to 6 months. Medical Conditions, Maternity leave, leaving the area for a short time, would be cause for placing membership on hold. Paperwork will be required and proof of the above mentioned would be needed. Credit extension of my membership will not be issued/granted for other reasons such as "didn't come last month" etc. **MUST BE DONE BY THE 5TH OR 20TH TO EFFECT DRAFT.**
- As a member, I am able to bring two out of town guest(s) for a fee of \$5.00 person, per visit for an unlimited number of visits. I am able to bring TWO local residents per unit at \$5 per person. More than 2 guests will be charged a fee of \$15 per person. After one visit, they must purchase a membership in order to continue to use the facility or pay \$15 per person every visit. GUEST REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED! ALL TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP ARE TO BE ABIDED BY GUESTS.

I personally assume all risks and hazards attendant to the use of the facilities, use of the equipment or participation in programming in consideration of my voluntary participation.
